CODE GENERATION

New one remote control has no code assigned.

This procedure removes the old stored codes and generates new codes for all 4 buttons.

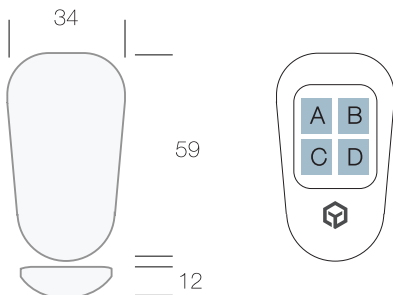
- Press button A, then immediately button B and keep then pressed.
- The led blinks slowly.
- Wait about 8 seconds until the led will flash faster.
- Release button A only.
- The led turn off for about 1 second then blinks quickly.
- Release button B as well.
- Now on each button has been assigned a new different code on more than a million different combinations.

WARNING! At the first usage, do always the code generation.

HOW TO LEARN A CODE

- Press button A, then immediately button B and keep then pressed.
- The led starts blinking.
- Release the button which is not to be copied on to.
- The led emits 2 flashes.
- Press and hold the button of the external radio control X which you want to copy the code.
- The LED flashes irregularly for a while, then remains steady to indicate that the copy has been made.
- Release the button pressed on the external radio control and TE002CF.
- The same operations can be carried out for buttons C and D.

TIPS During the code learning operation, bring the source remote control and the TE002CF as close as possible.
